This refers to your application for a byproduct material (radio-isotope) license.

The Commission has entered into an agreement with the State of New York whereby the State assumed regulatory authority over byproduct materials (radioisotopes) licensing effective October 15, 1962. Your application has been transmitted to the New York State Coordinating Council on Atomic Energy, Alfred E. Smith State Office Building, P. O. Box 7036, Albany 1, New York, for appropriate action. Future communications concerning licensing the possession and use of radioisotopes within New York should be directed to that organization.

The enclosed Part 150, "Exemptions and Continued Regulatory Authority in Agreement States Under Section 274", Title 10, Code of Federal Regulations, explains the areas of regulatory authority retained by the Commission and those areas turned over to the State.
