This is in response to your request for information on Holtec International's Holtite-A neutron shielding material and NAC International's NS-4-FR neutron shielding material. Holtec submitted a proprietary report to the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) in a letter dated June 9, 2000, in which they discussed the differences and similarities between the two materials.
