Subject: IOLB Public Comment #1 - Security

George/Diane:

I went to see Bob Skelton this morning in regards to IOLB Public Comment #1. If you recall, this is the response that Skip Young prepared and he took issue with one sentence regarding criticality and fuel heatup, located in the last paragraph of Section 4.3.2. After reading the response again, I thought we needed to perhaps modify the last paragraph in 4.3.2, so I asked Bob how we should merge Skip's writeup into the body to clarify any confusion with 10 CFR 73.51.

While reviewing Skip Young's response, Bob stated that he has concern with it (the first sentence states that 10 CFR 73.51 provides proper physical protection for wet and dry storage). Bob says he wouldn't be concerned if it stated only dry storage. So he wants to meet with Skip to discuss it. I suggested that when Skip returns from vacation next week, we all get together so that we can discuss Bob's concerns and also discuss revising the last paragraph of Section 4.3.2.

Sorry if this causes any further confusion. But it doesn't make much sense to provide the clarification in the public comments without changing the portion of 4.3.2 which is causing the confusion. And since I am not an expert with Security issues, I just felt the need to clarify this before the report goes into concurrence.
