Subject: Consequence Calcs

Jason - based on a quick reading of your draft input, results for several of the consequence measures noted in the August 25 user need letter are still needed to support the comparisons we plan to include in the report, specifically,

- the latent cancer fatality results at 1000 miles, at least for cases 13, 45a, 45b, 46b (consistent with that reported in NUREG-1150). We have added some discussion to put these results into context to allay your concern in reporting these results, and may also normalize the results to those for a reactor accident.

- condemned land are and interdicted land area

- economic impacts

(This is not a new request, since we specified this in our memo.) This info can be provided separately from the memo you now have in concurrence (by e-mail?)

Also, have you thought about the question "why is isn't cerium a bigger player since it has a long half life and health consequences similar to ruthenium?"
