PROPOSED LICENSE CONDITIONS FOR WESTINGHOUSE ELECTRIC CORPORATION  
AND METALS AND CONTROLS INC. (YOUR MEMO 1/10/69)

The District I Safeguards Office has reviewed the proposed license conditions for Westinghouse Electric Corporation and Metals and Controls Inc. and offers the following comments:

Westinghouse Electric Corp.

1. Page 5 of 7, Section 7.3 - Thirty days is too long a time allowance for the posting of entries into a transfer journal. A ten day limit for the posting of these entries would seem more reasonable and practical.
2. Page 6 of 7, Section 8.2 - The provisional values of 1.5% for MUF and 1.6% for NOL's is not reasonable. This means that as much as 3.1% of the SNM could fall into these categories. These values seem much too high in view of the operations at Westinghouse.
3. Page 7 of 7, Appendix A, Sections 3.12 and 3.13 - Are there any statistically valid approaches to the sampling plan to be used by Westinghouse? A valid plan should be established to give some confidence in the total quantity of the receiving lot.
4. General - Additional information is required as requested in enclosure 2.
