*4 The DOE agreement, Review of Foreign Research Reactor Spent Nuclear Fuel Shipments, was signed on 03/31/1998 with a completion date of 09/30/1999 & funding of \$60,000. On 09/02/1998, modification #1 added \$60,000. On 09/25/1998, modification #2 changed the statement of work. On 12/03/1998, modification #3 added \$150,000 to support an expedited review and evaluation of certificates of compliance of foreign countries submitted for revalidation by DOT under 49 CFR 171.12. On 02/09/1999, modification #4 provided another \$200,000. Tracy Mustin, DOE program manager of the DOE Office of Spent Fuel Management, Office of Nuclear Material and Facility Stabilization, clarified in a letter, dated 03/15/1999, that all funds applied to the interagency agreement may be used for all tasks in the SOW and in any subsequent modifications; the only limitation, outlined in Modification #3, is a ceiling of \$600,000 in FY 1999 for the task of reviewing and evaluating certificates of compliance for foreign-owned transportation packages. Program code 202820 has been combined with program code 202812. MOD #5, signed 05/21/1999, added \$150,000 of funding. MOD #6, signed 09/29/1999, extended the expiration date to 09/30/2003. Total funding is \$620,000.

*5 The DOE agreement is for a performance period from 07/09/1997 to 03/01/1998. DOE funded \$250,000 (\$127,000 for CEN and \$123,000 for NMSS). Modification #1, signed on 01/30/1998, extended this agreement to 09/30/1998. Modification #2, signed on 10/14/1998, extended this agreement to 09/30/1999. Modification #3, signed on 05/14/1999, provided another \$75,000. Modification #4, signed on 11/08/99, extended this agreement to 09/30/2000. Agreement is in the process of being modified to extend the performance date. FY 2000 unobligated carryover is \$7,248.53. Per B. Jennifer Davis in NMSS, this agreement will be extended in FY 2001.

Amendment #1 at the end of FY 1993 provided \$1,623,000 of new funds (\$973,000 for CEN and \$650,000 for RES) and extended the performance period to 06/14/1996. Amendment #2, signed on 09/29/1994, provided \$1,500,000 of new funds (\$850,000 for CEN and \$650,000 for RES), the performance end date remained 06/14/1996. Amendment #3, signed on 09/29/1995, provided \$1,000,000 of new funds (\$600,000 for CEN and \$400,000 for RES) and extended the performance period to 06/30/1997. Amendment #5, signed on 03/20/1997, provided \$568,000 of new funds (for CEN) and extended the performance end date to 09/30/1998. Amendment #6, signed on 09/03/1998, extended the completion date to 12/31/1999. The total agreement amount is \$5,991,000 (\$3,791,000 for CEN and \$2,200,000 for RES). In FY 1998, RES deobligated its prior-year unexpended balance of \$5,123.35. In memo, dated 11/23/1999, DCPM sent letter requesting extension to 09/30/2000. Amendment #7, signed on 01/21/2000, extended the completion date to 09/01/2000. Amendment #8, signed on 09/01/2000, extended the completion date to 09/01/2002.
- *8 The Defense Threat Reduction Agency (DTRA, formerly DSWA) IACRO #97-8801, signed on 04/10/1998, provided \$30,000 with an expiration date of 09/30/1999. Amendment #1, signed on 07/30/1998, provided an additional \$20,000. Amendment #2, signed on 11/20/1998, provided another \$200,000. FY 1999 unobligated carryover is \$95,033.56 (\$17,000 for CEN and \$78,033.56 for RES). Amendment #3, signed on 10/22/99, extended the completion date to 09/30/2001.
- *9 A reimbursable employee detail with the University of Illinois was signed on 3/13/98 with a period of performance from 03/15/1998 to 03/14/2000. The University of Illinois provided an initial advance of \$100,833. The total estimated amount for the agreement is \$205,920. The University provided an additional \$52,544 advance in October 1998 for estimated costs through 09/14/1999. In August 1999, the University provided another \$52,543. In FY 1999, this agreement was under CEN. In FY 2000, this agreement is under CIO. Memorandum, dated 03/21/2000, extended the period of performance through 05/13/00 and provided an additional \$18,600. In May 2000, the University provided another \$94,400 and extended the period of performance to 03/14/01.
- *10 Funds received from GSA via the On-Line Payment and Collection (OPAC) System for NRC's recycling receipts are available for the NRC Childcare Development Tuition Assistance Program per Section 608 of P.L. 104-208 and a February 6, 1997, memorandum from Hugh Thompson, the former EDO. Allocation of \$33,176.37 of new reimbursable funds was received on 09/01/1999. Allocation of \$34,296.77 per the May 5, 2000, memorandum from W. Travers, EDO. Allocation of \$12,167.21 per the October 17, 2000, memorandum from W. Travers, EDO.
- *11 The A.I.D. nonexpenditure transfer of \$5.5 million into NRC's 31X0200 account was received in FY 1994 as follows: \$3 million for Russia and \$2.5 million for Ukraine.
