This letter confirms the telephone conversation between Mr. Jeff Thomas of your staff and Mr. Michael Franovich of this office on May 22, 2001, concerning an Annual Assessment Meeting requested by us which is scheduled for July 10, 2001, at 1:00 p.m. The purpose of the meeting is to discuss the NRC Reactor Oversight Process Annual Assessment of your McGuire Nuclear Station. During the meeting, we recognize that you may have information you want to present to us or any members of the public in attendance. Accordingly, if you so desire, after our presentation you will be afforded an opportunity to respond to any information contained in the Annual Assessment Letter and to discuss any new or existing programs that are designed to maintain or improve your current performance. The location of the meeting will be onsite (12700 Hagers Ferry Road, Huntersville, NC) in the South Administration Building (number 7438), Room 155. State and Local Government Officials have been invited to the Annual Assessment Meeting.

A separate meeting will be held with these officials at the same location shortly after the conclusion of the Annual Assessment Meeting. The purpose of this meeting is to discuss the regulatory role of the NRC, the role of the McGuire resident inspectors, and the avenues that are available to bring concerns to the NRC. Both meetings are open meetings per "Staff Meetings Open to the Public; Final Policy Statement" (September 20, 2000; 65 FR 56964).
