PURPOSE: The NRC staff has developed an improved schedule model for the review of license renewal applications based on the experience gained from the first applications. The model reflects the current process being used for reviewing renewal applications and provides the flexibility needed to adjust interim milestones to accommodate the five applications being submitted in 2001 as well as in the future. A draft of the model was discussed with VEPCO, Duke, and Exelon in a meeting on May 21, 2001. This meeting is for the staff to receive comments on the draft model from the three applicants and to continue discussions on developing integrated review schedules using the new model.
