### INTERVIEW REPORT WITH DELSA L. FRAZIER

FRAZIER, was reinterviewed on May 15, 1999, at the Tennessee Valley Authority (TVA) Power Services Building, Chattanooga, Tennessee, where she is employed as a metallurgist. Also present at the interview at FRAZIER's request was Ed VIGLUICCI, Senior Legal Counsel, TVA. After being advised of the interviewer's official identity and the purpose of the interview, FRAZIER provided the following information in substance:

FRAZIER said her office follows the Quality Assurance (QA) procedures for laboratory procedures that are prescribed for other operations at the Central Laboratory Services (CLS). She said that ongoing examinations that are revised, are assigned revision numbers, i.e. -1, -2. 7c

FRAZIER said her office "owned" the report, that is, controlled it, until it was officially sent to RIMS. Therefore, according to FRAZIER, the report can be called back from distribution, all copies destroyed and another report can be issued under the same report number, since the first copy essentially no longer exists.

FRAZIER said she did not know that a copy of the June 2<sup>nd</sup> report had been provided to Westinghouse and that Vonda SISSON did not tell her that information. FRAZIER acknowledged that once she released a report, that she had no way of knowing whether or not other parties had received photocopies.

An endorsement, or supplement, to the June 2<sup>nd</sup> report was approved by FRAZIER on June 12, 1995. FRAZIER said the endorsement, which only applied to the June 2<sup>nd</sup> report, was entered into RIMS.
