This letter confirms the telephone conversation between Mr. P. Salas of your staff and Mr. P. Fredrickson of this office on May 29, 2001, concerning an Annual Assessment Meeting requested by us which is scheduled for July 10, 2001 at 1:00 p.m. The purpose of the meeting is to discuss the NRC Reactor Oversight Process Annual Assessment of your Sequoyah facility. During the meeting, we recognize you may have information you want to present to us or any members of the public in attendance. Accordingly, if you so desire, after our presentation you will be afforded an opportunity to respond to any information contained in the Annual Assessment Letter and to discuss any new or existing programs that are designed to maintain or improve your current performance. The location of the meeting will be at the Sequoyah Nuclear Training Center Auditorium, Soddy Daisy, TN. State and local government officials have been invited to the Annual Assessment Meeting.

A separate meeting will be held with these officials at the same location in Room 215, shortly after the conclusion of the Annual Assessment Meeting. The purpose of this meeting is to discuss the regulatory role of the NRC, the role of the Sequoyah resident inspectors and the avenues that are available to bring concerns to the NRC. Both these meetings are open meetings per "Staff Meetings Open to the Public; Final Policy Statement" (September 20, 2000; 59 FR 48340).
