Dear Mr. Sumner:

The purpose of this letter is to inform you of the Nuclear Regulatory Commission's (NRC) completion of activities related to the subject complaint of discrimination involving the Hatch Nuclear Plant.

The NRC's Office of Investigations reviewed the complaint, and Southern Nuclear Operating Company, Inc. (SNOC) was notified of the results of the investigation by letter dated March 2, 2001. The OI investigation, Case No. 2-2000-012, concluded that the evidence developed did not substantiate that the complainant was subjected to illegal discrimination by SNOC. In that letter, SNOC was also advised that the NRC would withhold its judgement on whether or not enforcement was warranted in this matter until after a final decision had been reached by the DOL.

On May 9, 2001, the DOL Office of Administrative Law Judges (ALJ) issued a Recommended Decision and Order Approving Settlement, approving the settlement of the complaint (Case 2001-ERA-0005). Through a Memorandum of Understanding with DOL, the NRC reviewed the settlement agreement and determined that it was not prohibitive with respect to the requirements of 10 CFR 50.7(f). In addition, the DOL Administrative Review Board was not petitioned for review of the case, rendering the ALJ approval of the settlement a final DOL decision and closing the case.

Based on the OI conclusions regarding the complaint, the DOL's closure of the case, and our review of the settlement agreement, we plan no further action in this matter. If you have any questions regarding this case, you may contact me at 404-562-4421, or at the above address.
