
Dear Mr. Meserve:

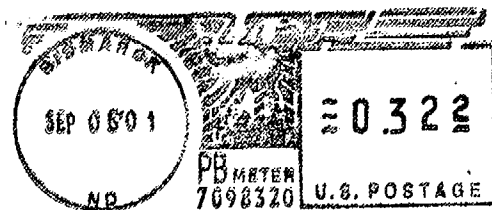
