

1. I assume that the point here is that the drivers are not "L" cleared. It is implicit in this paragraph but not explicit.
 2. Apparently, reference to Mr. Williams has become reference to Mr. Sherman.
 3. This is "authorized" by license? Is there additional material at the site? Yes.
191,297 gms scrap and 646,077 gms of UO₂ and scrap in storage at Bldg 300
 4. "Leased and supply" material - this may be common terminology in the industry
Section 53 (leased) Non-Accident 53 (Supply Agreement) See Ward's memo dated 12/6/66
but I am not familiar with it.
 5. Looks as if NFS has a lot of material - I suppose this is within authorized limits? A total of material possessed would have been desirable. The number of items of material possessed would have been desirable.
 6. At shift change is there a security guard at the gate? Yes Security guard at gate at shift change.
 7. The meaning is understood but "angles inward" may have been a better selection of words. - agree and corrected
 8. Does this imply that the fence is closer than 6 feet to other buildings? Is there a distance requirement in the Manual? See Exhibit A - measurement taken of Bldg 300 where we have a security interest adjacent to main entrance
 9. A photograph would have been useful here. Dr. Roth and Williams submit it. It was prepared in San Francisco.

10B From the statement in 10A, is it correct that the gate at the NW corner near the Ceramics Bldg and the vehicle gate west of parking lot No. 2 ~~normally~~ are not used? Are they locked all the time? Yes, except when not in use
11. I assume you cannot exit thru an emergency gate unless these are unlocked at a central control point by the security guard. Is this an electric lock that opens all locks at the same time? Does Joe know about this? This may inhibit emergency evacuation if the roving security guard (11A) happens to be away from the lock control at the time of an emergency.
 12. Are the doors key-locked at times other than night? Yes. See heading specifically dealing with Security of Materials in Storage. The building is key-locked when not in use.
 13. Is a security alarm required? It is desired to have a security alarm system installed in the area of the storage area for control of the area which is under security critical control.
 14. Is this section used for storage of SNM? - No. See inventory (Introduction and 1st item mentioned under heading "Materials in Storage", which is a specific title dealing "Security of Materials in Storage."

15. Are the doors locked other than at night? *Yes. - No material stored in this section of building 300*
16. In view of the statement of 16A, p. 4, is the work in this building only for 5 days a week? If so, what is provided the other two days?
17. Comment 16 applies - Also, what type of control is exercised? Is there administrative control as in the Metals Building? Okay - answered on p. 8.
Administrative control is being exercised
18. Are the change houses separate structures? - *No*
19. Is administrative control exercised? *Yes.*
20. During other than the day shift, this is turned in to whom? *To guard who issues badges. Security is maintained by guard.*
- 20A. Are the yellow and red badges used by visitors or only by employees? *At times of study materials issued with badges. Visitors are under escort. System is yellow.*
21. Leased and supply? *Leased in addition to own materials*
22. Are alarms required? *No. Have other controls*
23. At shift changes is this guard ^{at} ~~off~~ the entrance gates? - *Yes*
24. Is this pre-employment check a security investigation of some kind? - *A pre-employment investigation includes references to character, personality, reputation, etc.*
25. Was this statement of Williams in response to some stated deficiency on the part of the survey team? - *Responded to discussions about clearance*
26. I assume there is no reason for this to be a security area. *Right*
27. How is access denied? - *Administratively controlled by building employees*
28. Should it have a security alarm? *Does not have a security alarm. A security alarm would be a good idea.*
29. I assume from your memo that a strict application of Manual chapter provisions would require additional lighting. *Not required in view of other controls. As per my memo of 11/1/54*
30. Ryder Truck Lines is a common carrier as well as a truck rental firm? *Yes. The point here is that the building is not a security area.*
