SUBJECT: RADIOLOGICAL CONTINGENCY PLAN CHANGES FOR GENERAL ATOMICS
(TAC NOS. MB2061 AND MB2062)

Dear Dr. Asmussen:

This letter acknowledges receipt of your letter dated May 25, 2001, which transmitted changes to the Radiological Contingency Plan (a.k.a. Emergency Plan) for General Atomics submitted under the provisions of 10 CFR 50.54(q).

Based on your determination that the changes do not decrease the overall effectiveness of your emergency plan, and that it continues to meet the requirements of applicable parts of Appendix E to 10 CFR Part 50, NRC approval is not required. Our initial screening of these changes using NUREG-0849, "Standard Review Plan for the Review and Evaluation of Emergency Plans for Research and Test Reactors" indicates them to be in accordance with 10 CFR 50.54(q) and that your plan continues to meet the requirements of Appendix E to 10 CFR Part 50. Implementation of these changes will be subject to inspection to confirm that they did not decrease the effectiveness of your emergency plan.
