SUBJECT: EXELON MEETING SUMMARY CONCERNING EMERGENCY  
PREPAREDNESS PROGRAM

Dear Mr. Kingsley:

On October 1, 2001, a meeting, open for public observation, was held at the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC), Region I office, between Exelon Nuclear, MidAtlantic Regional Operating Group, and the NRC staff. The purpose of the meeting was to discuss changes to the implementation of your Emergency Preparedness program at the following nuclear power plants: Oyster Creek, Three Mile Island, Peach Bottom and Limerick. You requested this meeting based on the results of several Exelon self-assessments and NRC findings identified during a program inspection conducted in July 2001. A copy of your presentation slides was entered into the NRC's document system (ADAMS), accession number ML012750081.

The NRC was represented by both managers and staff from the region and NRC Headquarters. Also participating in the meeting were representatives from the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA), RIII, Pennsylvania Emergency Management Agency (PEMA), and the Department of Environmental Protection Agency (DEP). Members of the public and press were also in attendance. The enclosure lists the attendees for the meeting.

Although you believe the current EP program remains ready to effectively protect public health and safety, you stated it did not meet Exelon's vision of an industry-leading program. Your presentation included changes and or improvements to: (1) EP organization/staffing; (2) EP equipment reliability; (3) EP program processes; and (4) the corrective action process.

The meeting was of mutual benefit and the NRC staff appreciated your candor with regards to the changes needed in your EP program and emphasized the importance of maintaining an adequate program in a state of readiness for responding to a radiological event.
