Dear Ms. Pastis:

This is in regards to GPU Nuclear's letter on August 3, 2000, requesting the renewal of the Biological Opinion and Incidental Take Statement for the Oyster Creek Nuclear Generating Station in Ocean County, New Jersey. The previous Biological Opinion was issued on September 21, 1995, and the Incidental Take Statement for this facility expires on September 21, 2000.

The National Marine Fisheries Service (NMFS) has received the Biological Assessment for this project titled "Assessment of the Impacts of the Oyster Creek Nuclear Generating Station on Kemp's Ridley (*Lepidochelys kempi*), Loggerhead (*Caretta caretta*), and Atlantic Green (*Chelonia mydas*) Sea Turtles." As you know, consultation under Section 7 of the Endangered Species Act is between the NMFS and the federal action agency, the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) in this case. The purpose of this letter is to request that the NRC reinitiate consultation under Section 7 of the Endangered Species Act of 1973, as amended, given that the term of the Incidental Take Statement will be expiring within a month. The NMFS will not begin the process of reinitiation until we receive the request and supporting information from the NRC.
