Please provide the NRC staff with any information you may have regarding (1) the legal title to the property in question, including information about any leases, liens or other encumbrances on the title, (2) the chronology of the development of the transmission corridor, (3) copies of permit applications for construction, operations and maintenance of the transmission corridor, (4) a brief discussion of current and future responsibilities for operation and maintenance of the transmission line, and (5) any alternatives you consider feasible to address the SHPO's concerns.
