SUBJECT: SUMMARY OF NOVEMBER 6, 2001, MEETING WITH NUCLEAR
ENERGY INSTITUTE ON EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS
SIGNIFICANCE DETERMINATION PROCESS

A publically observed meeting between Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) staff, industry, and representatives of the Nuclear Energy Institute (NEI) was held November 6, 2001, at NEI headquarters in Washington, D. C. Those attending the meeting are listed in Attachment 1.

The purpose of the meeting was to discuss and receive comments from the NEI Task Force on Emergency Preparedness on the draft revision of the Emergency Preparedness Significance Determination Process (EP SDP), NRC Manual Chapter 0609, Appendix B. Comments received and a proposed revision to an EP SDP flowchart are contained in Attachment 2. Questions were discussed regarding the industry comments and the basis for the EP SDP. In general, the comments were focused on wording improvements rather than conceptual changes. NRC staff stated that the comments were appreciated and would be considered when NRC finalizes the EP SDP. The meeting closed after completing the discussion.
