Separately, the NRC issued an amendment to the Indian Point 2 technical specifications today. The amendment allows Con Ed, among other things, to remove the containment recirculation filters and charcoal absorbers. The request for amendment - which is based on the NRC's revised calculation of the amount of fission products that would be released to the containment during a severe accident - was submitted by ConEd in November 1999.
