have turned security issues into a top concern in the Federal community. These stories have made building security one of the primary challenges facing facility managers and law enforcement organizations nationwide.

After the bombing of the Alfred P. Murrah Federal Building, the Department of Justice launched a review of the vulnerability of federal buildings to terrorist attacks and other forms of violence. The United States Marshals Service (USMS) coordinated a vulnerability assessment study with participating agencies including the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI), U.S. Secret Service, General Services Administration (GSA), State Department, Social Security Administration and Department of Defense. The purpose of this study was to assess vulnerability of Federal buildings and develop minimum security standards.

A security matrix has been provided on page 4 to identify your facility's recommended standard.



Once you determine your facility's necessary upgrades, use this publication as a product guide to purchase any upgrades.
