Supplemental Information Regarding Application for Order and  
Conforming Administrative Amendments for Transfers of Licenses

On behalf of Reliant Energy, Inc. (formerly known as Houston Lighting & Power Company and referred to herein as Reliant Energy), STP Nuclear Operating Company submits the following supplemental information regarding its Application for Order and Conforming Administrative Amendments for Transfers of Licenses (Application) submitted in the referenced letter. The pending license transfer application requests that the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) consent to the direct and indirect transfers of control of Reliant Energy's ownership interest in the South Texas Project Electric Generating Station, Units 1 and 2 (STPEGS).


This confirms that to the extent that Reliant Energy continues to hold its ownership interest in STPEGS upon the formation of CenterPoint Energy, Inc., Reliant Energy will remain financially qualified to retain such ownership interest, because it will continue to recover its costs through a traditional ratemaking mechanism under rates in effect until January 1, 2002. After January 1, 2002, Reliant Energy will operate its generation assets, obtain revenues, and pay its costs in the manner described in the five-year *pro forma* projections for Texas Genco LP that were previously submitted. As such, the same five-year *pro forma* applies to Reliant Energy with respect to the requested NRC approval of an indirect transfer of control of STPEGS in connection with the formation of CenterPoint Energy, Inc. In addition, Reliant Energy's revenues from its transmission and distribution business (but not its sales from its generating facilities) will remain subject to cost-of-service rate regulation, and the company will continue to maintain investment grade credit ratings. As the *pro forma* and this information demonstrate, Reliant Energy will remain financially qualified.

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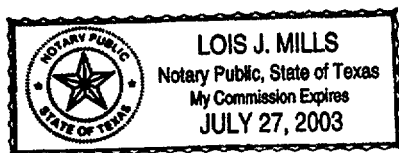




