I am responding to your September 18, 2001 letter on the inspection frequency/priority for Intravascular Brachytherapy (IVB) licensees.

We have not yet made a final determination on the Inspection Frequency. We plan to make a final determination and revise Inspection Manual Chapter 2800 as part of our activities to develop implementation guidance for Part 35. Tentatively, we believe it may be assigned to Priority 1 because it is a new technology and involves high dose rates.

However, until we make a final determination, we do not object if you assign IVBs a priority of 3.
