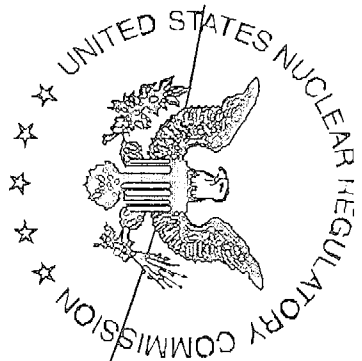

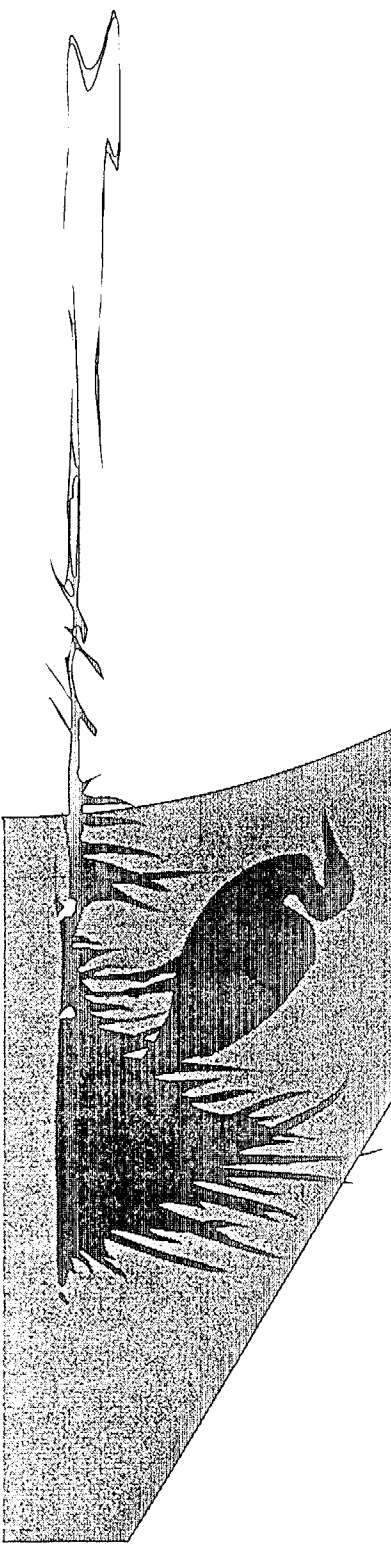

# Peach Bottom, Units 2 and 3, License Renewal

---

- Current operating licenses expire in 2013 (Unit 2) and 2014 (Unit 3)
- Application requests authorization to operate units for an additional 20 years

- Safety review
- Environmental review
- Advisory Committee on Reactor Safeguards
- Plant inspections



# National Environmental Policy Act

---

- NEPA requires Federal agencies to use a systematic approach to consider environmental impacts
- An Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) is required for major Federal actions significantly affecting the quality of the human environment
- Commission has determined that an EIS will be prepared for a license renewal action



# Decision Standard for Environmental Review

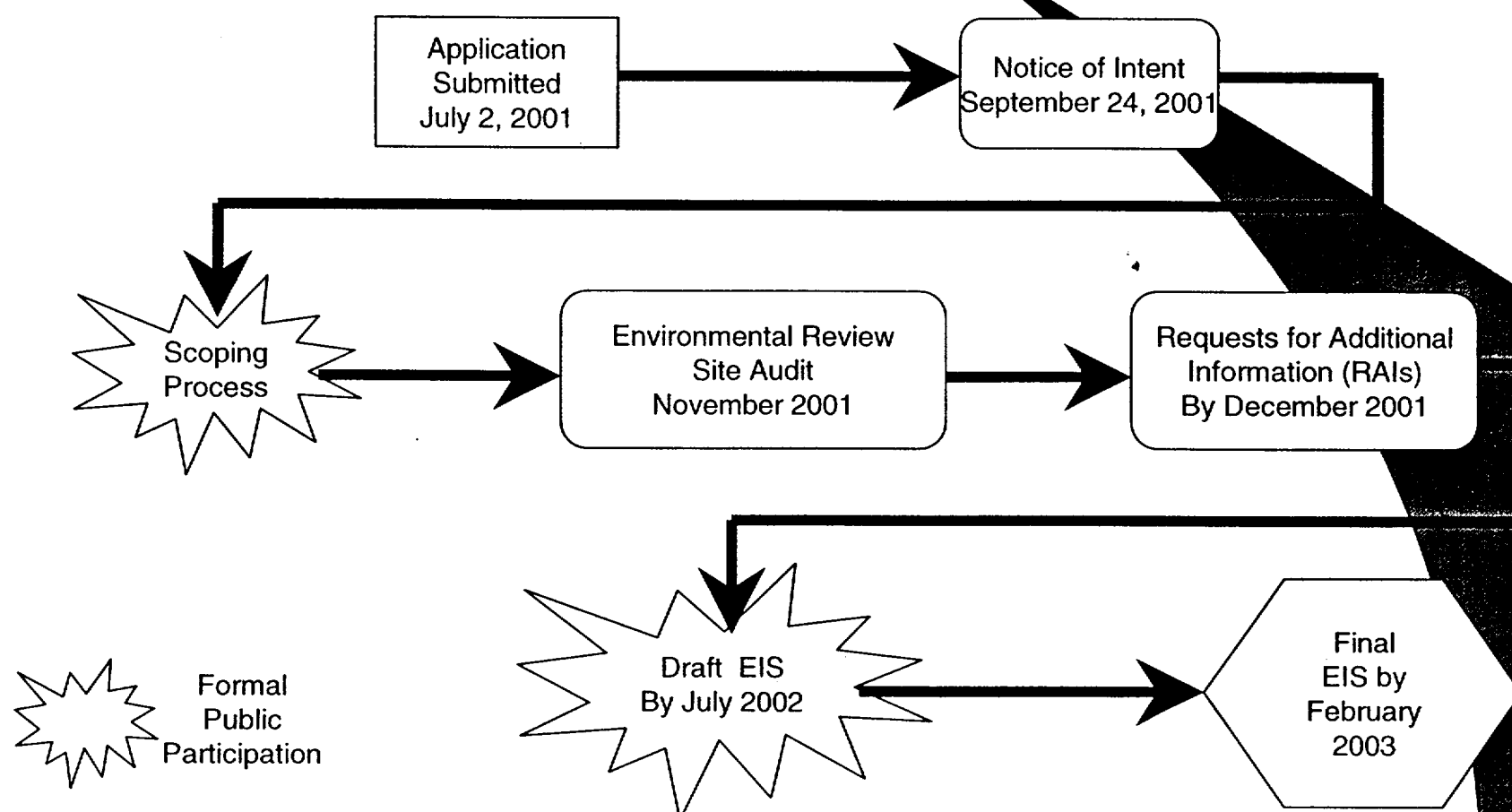
---

To determine whether or not the adverse environmental impacts of license renewal for Peach Bottom, Units 2 and 3, are so great that preserving the option of license renewal for energy planning decisionmakers would be unreasonable.



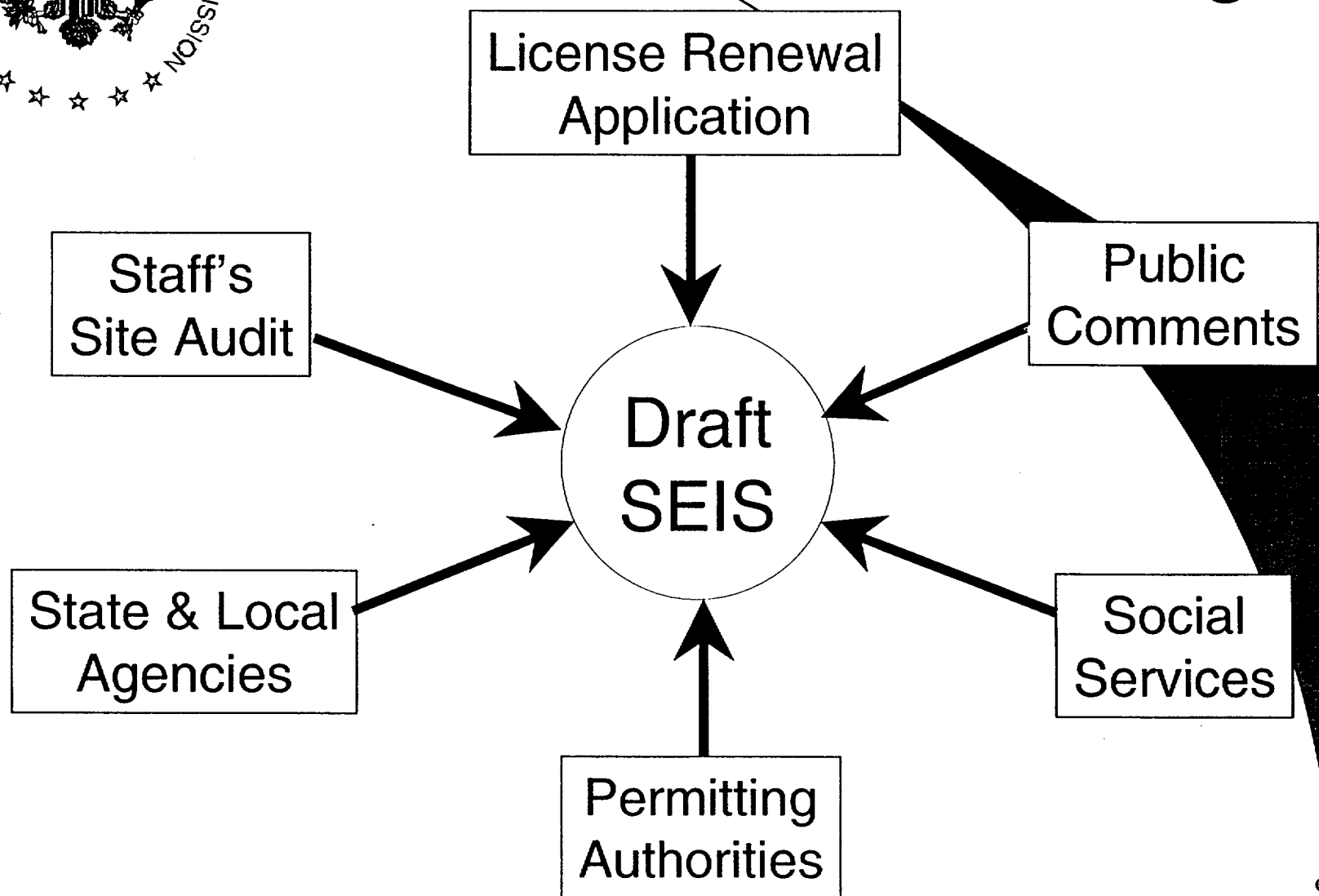


# Environmental License Renewal Process



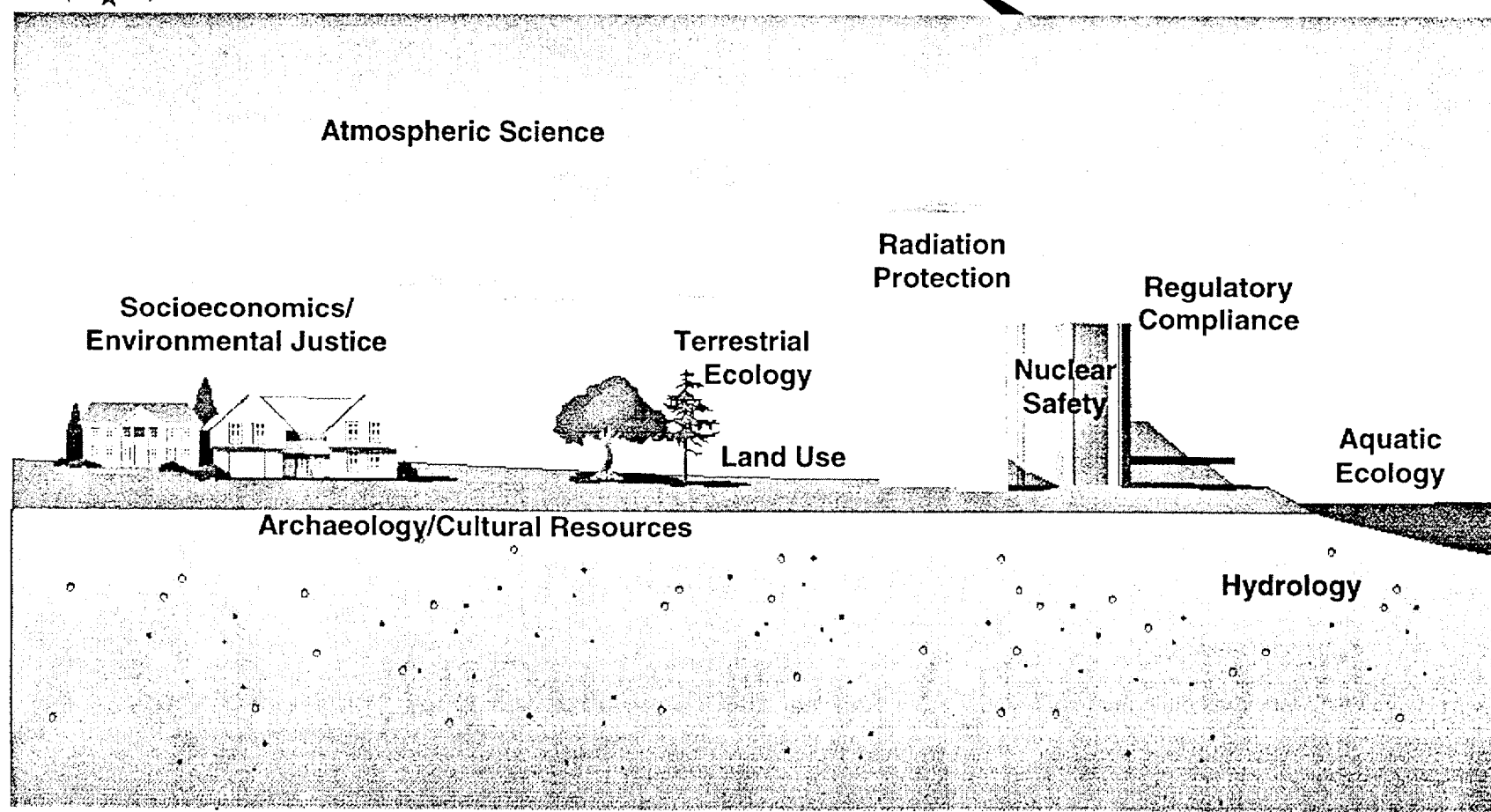
