(TAC NOS. MB1577 AND MB1579)

Dear Mr. Myers:

The Commission issued Amendment No. 246 to Facility Operating License No. DPR-66 and Amendment No. 124 to Facility Operating License No. NPF-73 for the Beaver Valley Power Station, Unit Nos. 1 and 2 (BVPS-1 and 2), on January 24, 2002. These amendments approved relocation of certain BVPS-1 and 2 technical specification requirements to the Licensing Requirements Manual or to the Offsite Dosage Calculation Manual consistent with the criteria of Title 10 of the *Code of Federal Regulations* Section 50.36.

The licensee requested an implementation period of 120 days in its March 28, 2001, letter. However, an implementation period of 30 days was mistakenly documented in the subject amendments. This letter changes the implementation period to 120 days to reflect the licensee's request.

Enclosures 1 and 2 contain the revised pages of the license amendments reflecting the new implementation period for BVPS-1 and 2, respectively. It is requested that you replace the previously issued page 2 of each Amendment with the respective enclosures.
