SUMMARY

By application dated January 4, 2002, as supplemented January 9, 2002, Westinghouse Electric Company LLC (Westinghouse), requested renewal of Certificate of Compliance No. 9272 for the Model CE-B1 package. Westinghouse did not request any design changes to the package. The certificate has been renewed for a five year term.

EVALUATION

Westinghouse requested renewal of Certificate of Compliance No. 9272 for the Model No. CE-B1 shipping package by application dated January 4, 2002. Westinghouse did not request any design changes to the package. In support of the renewal request Westinghouse submitted a consolidated application as specified in 10 CFR 71.38(a). The staff reviewed the consolidated application and concluded that the consolidated application incorporated the changes to the Safety Analysis Report that were previously referenced in the Certificate of Compliance. The staff reviewed the documents referenced in the certificate and determined that the required documentation was available and complete. Condition No. 5(c) of the certificate was revised to clarify that the Transport Index for criticality control is the same as the Criticality Safety Index as defined in the International Atomic Energy Agency Regulations for the Safe Transport of Radioactive Material (TS-R-1).

CONCLUSION

The certificate has been renewed for a five year term that expires on January 31, 2007. This change does not affect the ability of the package to meet the requirements of 10 CFR Part 71.
