
I am writing to request that I be placed upon the service lists for the Indian Point nuclear power plant units 2 and 3.

As the Commission and staff are well aware, I have been and continue to be actively involved in the efforts by concerned citizens to see that the reactors on the Indian Point site are adequately regulated by the NRC. I have been on the service list in the recent past as a result of my own petitions and have been consulting with those that currently have petitions pending before the Commission.

With the shutdown of the NRC's website and my inability to access the abysmal Adams system, the service list is the only option left to me. There are no local public document rooms left anywhere in the nation and the NRC has removed the document room from Washington and relocated it to NRC headquarters in Rockville, Maryland.
