Subject: STOLEN PORTABLE GAUGE

The Tennessee Division of Radiological Health (the Division) notified the Region II office and the NRC Operations Center that the licensee had reported a stolen portable gauge. The gauge was a Troxler, model 3401B, serial number 13284, containing 8 millicuries (296 megabecquerels) of cesium-137 and 40 millicuries (1.48 gigabecquerels) of americium-241 as radioactive sources, locked inside the gauge at the time of theft. The gauge was secured in a locked container and chained to the bed of a pickup truck parked at a YMCA parking lot in Old Hickory, TN (near Nashville, TN). The chain's padlock was cut and the container with the locked gauge was stolen sometime during the night of Tuesday, February 5, 2002. Local police were notified of the event.

The Division has the event under investigation and a press release has been prepared.

Region II received initial notification of this occurrence by telephone from the Division. The Division also notified the NRC Operations Center, and the Tennessee Emergency Management Agency. This information has been discussed with the Division and is current as of 1:00 p.m., Wednesday, February 6, 2002.
