By letter dated August 24, 2001, Entergy Nuclear Generation Company (ENGCO) applied for an order consenting to the transfer of the operating authority for the Pilgrim Nuclear Power Station (Pilgrim) Facility Operating License No. DPR-35 and transfer of Materials License 20-07626-04 to Entergy Nuclear Operations, Incorporated (ENO).

By letter dated October 19, 2001, the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) informed you that we anticipated completing our evaluation of the ENGCO application and, if acceptable, issuing the appropriate order by February 28, 2002. During the review of the ENGCO application we determined that additional information was needed to complete our evaluation. In a conference call with the Pilgrim licensing staff on January 17, 2002, we discussed the specific information needed and our reasons for requesting that information. The Pilgrim licensing staff stated that the information would be provided to the NRC by February 7, 2002. As of February 15, 2002, we have not received the requested information. Therefore, we will no longer be able to issue the order by February 28, 2002. Once we receive an acceptable response to our request, we anticipate that we will be able to issue the order within 4 weeks.
