TEST RESULTS

For the 2001 calendar year, random screens were performed on 53.24% of the Wolf Creek population.

Wolf Creek submitted blind performance specimens in accordance with 10 CFR 26, Appendix A, Section 2.8(e)(2), requirements. There were no reportable events.

WCNOC Employees

One WCNOC employee tested positive for alcohol on a random screen. Following evaluation the individual voluntarily terminated his employment with Wolf Creek. One WCNOC employee was tested on a for-cause screen. The results of that screening were negative, therefore no additional actions were needed.

Contractors

One contractor tested positive for alcohol on a pre-access screen. The individual's unescorted access was denied.
