Dear Mr. Kurtz:

We have completed our review of the proposed Revisions 15 and 16 to the Sargent & Lundy (S&L) Topical Report (TR) SL-TR-1A, Nuclear Quality Assurance Program. Revision 16 was submitted by your letter dated May 7, 2001. Revision 15 was not submitted for prior NRC approval because, as stated in the S&L letter, the changes do not constitute reductions in commitments in the program description as accepted by the NRC. Changes that qualify as reductions in commitments are described by the regulation at 10 CFR 50.54(a)(3).

Revision 16, with respect to 10 CFR Part 50, contains only one change that is classified as a reduction in commitment. This change adopts the position of Regulatory Issue Summary 2000-18, "Guidance on Managing Quality Assurance Records in Electronic Media," which provides guidance on storing and maintaining quality assurance (QA) records in electronic media, as stipulated by 10 CFR 50.71(d)(1). This guidance applies to QA records that are subject to the requirements of Criterion XVII of Appendix B. We find that Revisions 15 and 16 meet the requirements of Appendix B to 10 CFR Part 50, and are therefore acceptable.
