RE: Neutron Detectors

[REDACTED] The attached series of correspondence should serve to bring you up to date on the business aspects of the [REDACTED] proposal to build neutron detectors for commercial sale.

Apparently, [REDACTED] had given General Atomics [TRIGATEC] assurances that MU would build the detectors, and even quoted a price for doing so. The folks at General Atomics then incorporated [REDACTED] assurances and price quote into their contracts to build reactors for Thailand and Morocco – all this, without a written contract! At this point General Atomics is “holding the bag”.

[REDACTED] responses accurately reflect my position. We do not have a contract to supply these neutron detectors. We do not have an agreed price. If we are to develop a contract, it would have to be approved by the appropriate University officials. I am still wrestling with whether or not I want to participate in this enterprise. It is not a business, and thus it is not eligible for SBIR or STTR funding.

This might be one of the items we discuss when we meet with [REDACTED]
