**SUBJECT: Notification of Changes Affecting the Fort Calhoun Station (FCS) Site Security Plan, Safeguards Contingency Plan, and Security Training and Qualification Plan**

Pursuant to 10 CFR 50.54(p)(2), Omaha Public Power District (OPPD) submits this letter concerning recent changes that affected the FCS Site Security Plan, Safeguards Contingency Plan, and the Security Training and Qualification Plan.

Attachment 1 provides descriptions of these changes and justifications for the changes.

Changes identified in Attachment 1 have been incorporated into the FCS Site Security Plan, Safeguards Contingency Plan, and the Security Training and Qualification Plan.

These changes include the removal of shotguns, additional guidance regarding DD-214 forms, "Certificate of Release or Discharge from Active Duty," a change in the audit frequency for the Safeguards Contingency Plan, and removal of training requirements for the shotgun and revolver. These changes do not reduce the effectiveness of the FCS Site Security Plan, Safeguards Contingency Plan, or the Security Training and Qualification Plan.

This submittal contains safeguards information (Attachment 2) and must be controlled in accordance with 10 CFR 73.21. Controlled copy numbers 6, 7, and 18 are enclosed for the NRC Document Control Desk. Controlled copy numbers 19 and 20 are being transmitted to NRC Region IV. Controlled copy number 8 is being transmitted to the NRC Senior Resident Inspector at FCS.


