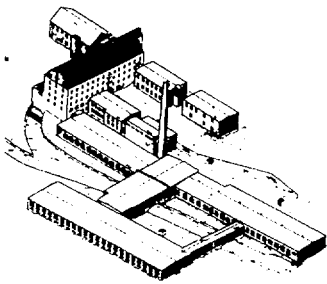

This is the 30 day follow-up report pursuant to 10 CFR 20.2203 regarding the loss of a Nuclear Static Eliminating Device as was reported on February 13, 2002.

We began a search for this device after receiving notification from the State of Connecticut that their records indicated that we had a source of ionizing radiation and a registration fee was due the state. Although the device was not found, an instruction manual for it was, and with that we were able to locate the Manufacturer which is NRD LLC of Grand Island, New York.

Based on information from NRD we conclude the following:

The device is a Nuclecel Static Eliminator, Model no. P-2031, Serial no. 46218.

It was last shipped to us on lease no. 036761 on December 13, 1991.

It was used on a compressed air supply line to a paint spray gun.

Because there is no further record of a lease renewal, we conclude it was last used during 1992.

Personnel who were involved in the use of the device are no longer with the company and efforts to locate them have been unsuccessful.

We have conducted a thorough search of the facility and have not found the device or any other information about it.

Current practices and procedures at this facility do not require the use of such a device.

There is nothing in future plans for this facility that would require the use of such a device.
