NRC STAFF'S RESPONSE TO INTERVENOR  
SKULL VALLEY BAND'S MOTION FOR PROTECTIVE ORDER

On March 4, 2002, Intervenor Skull Valley Band of Goshute Indians ("Skull Valley Band" or "Band") filed a "Motion for protective Order as to Certain Exhibits Attached to the Declaration of Leon D. Bear" ("Motion"). Therein, the Skull Valley Band requested that the Commission issue a Protective Order to preserve the confidentiality of two one-page exhibits that were attached to the Skull Valley Band's motion for directed certification, filed on March 4, 2002.<sup>1</sup> The referenced exhibits consist of a bank statement and a dividend check issued to a member of the Band, which the Band asserts contain proprietary financial information. The Band further indicates that "[o]nce the Board has accorded sufficient protection to these two financial documents, they will be served on the affected parties" (Motion at 2).

The NRC Staff ("Staff") herewith responds to the Skull Valley Band's Motion. For the reasons described in its Motion, the Staff believes that the referenced exhibits contain financial information belonging to the Band and certain of its members, that may properly be withheld from

public disclosure. See 10 C.F.R. § 2.790(a)(4).<sup>2</sup> Accordingly, the Staff does not oppose the Skull Valley Band's request that these documents be withheld from public disclosure.<sup>3</sup>
