**2) Physical Description**

This shipment will consist of 288 drums of Uranium Ore Concentrate (U-308) in 6 x 20' ocean containers. The total weight of the shipment is 114,704.7 kgs of U-308.

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3) Transportation and Route Schedule

The vessel will sail from Hamburg, Germany on October 7, 2001. The ocean transportation from Hamburg, Germany to Montreal, Quebec, Canada will be the responsibility of CANMAR Steamship Line. The vessel will unload at Montreal, Quebec, Canada on or about October 15, 2001. The containers will then be loaded onto the rail for importation to Detroit, MI. The containers will enter the USA at Detroit, MI on or about October 20, 2001, and will continue on rail to St. Louis, MO. The inland transportation from Montreal, PQ to Metropolis, IL will be the responsibility of RSB logistic Services Inc.


