The definition of "exceptional value waters" comes from PA's regs, and it's lengthy and convoluted. We recommend a summary as:

"Exceptional Value Waters" are surface waters of high quality (chemical purity and low toxicity) which Pennsylvania has determined to have exceptional ecological significance.

The attached file provides the full definition, from the State's regs. It's not a clear-cut definition (e.g., exceptional value waters are this, or this, or this, or this,).

I understand that Duane discussed the "aquatic pathway" with you, and forwarded a recommended word change, by e-mail. We understand that you are considering that issue, and will get back to us if you need anything further.
