SUBJECT: SUMMARY OF THE MARCH 28, 2002, MEETING WITH DETROIT
EDISON CO. TO DISCUSS FERMI PERFORMANCE

On March 28, 2002, a public meeting was held at the Monroe City Hall, Monroe, Michigan, between the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) and Detroit Edison Co. staff. The purpose of the meeting was to discuss NRC's assessment of Fermi's performance for the period of April 1, 2001 through December 31, 2001. In addition, Detroit Edison officials briefly discussed their own assessment of performance.

During the NRC presentation, an overall assessment of Fermi performance was provided. As explained in the Annual Assessment letter from NRC to William O'Connor, Jr., Vice President Nuclear Generating, Detroit Edison Co., dated March 4, 2002, reference ADAMS accession number ML020700251, Fermi remained in the Regulatory Response band as a result of the failure of an emergency diesel generator on (EDG) March 21, 2001. The licensee's actions for the EDG failure have been completed and the NRC completed a supplemental inspection of the issue. In accordance with the NRC's assessment matrix, the White finding and PI for this issue remain for one more quarter.
