Jim, as discussed the last day of the hearing, I am preparing a joint pleading identifying open items from the hearing, such as exhibits on which the Board has yet to rule on admission. I have been out of the office for several days, but I should be sending a draft to you and Sherwin this afternoon or tomorrow morning at the latest. I will include the exhibits you identified below in the draft. I would propose that the parties discuss their positions on the various open items before filing with the Board.
