The U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) will be responsible for reviewing Louisiana Energy Services' (LES) license application for the proposed gas centrifuge uranium enrichment plant. Under LES' current schedule, LES is planning to submit the application in December 2002. In our review, we will address the protection of public health and safety of the proposed facility. We will also address any environmental impacts in an Environmental Impact Statement we will prepare for the project.

The NRC's licensing process provides several formal opportunities for public participation. These opportunities include public meetings for scoping the Environmental Impact Statement, an opportunity to comment on the Draft Environmental Impact Statement in writing and in a public meeting, and an opportunity to petition for a hearing.
