Dear Commissioners and Staff:

By letter dated December 21, 2001, the Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PG&E) submitted an application to the U. S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) for a 10 CFR 72 site-specific license to build and operate an independent spent fuel storage installation (ISFSI) at the Diablo Canyon Power Plant site. The application included a Safety Analysis Report, Environmental Report, and other required documents in accordance with 10 CFR 72.


By letter dated August 29, 2002, the NRC staff requested additional information needed to continue their review of the Diablo Canyon ISFSI License Application. PG&E submitted its response to the NRC staff on October 15, 2002, in PG&E letter DIL-02-009.

As requested by Mr. J. R. Hall, two documents referenced in the Diablo Canyon ISFSI RAI response are listed in Enclosure 1 followed by the documents for use by the NRC staff in their review of the application. The fire protection evaluation of the HI-TRAC transportation route, which is attached to Enclosure 1, was incorrectly referenced in Probabilistic Risk Assessment (PRA) Calculation File No. PRA01-01, Revision 1. The date of the evaluation should have been March 6, 2002, rather than February 2002. PRA01-01 has been revised to reflect the actual issue date for the requested evaluation and is attached to Enclosure 2.
