

**MEETING REPORT
on the
Cabot Reading Site**

DATE: 29 January 2003

TIME: 1:00 pm

PLACE: Region I Public Meeting Room

PURPOSE: Technical meeting to discuss Cabot Reading site decommissioning issues

ATTENDEES: See Attachment A

BACKGROUND: The Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection (PADEP) requested to meet with NRC and Cabot to discuss technical concerns regarding the Cabot Reading site. The Agency for Toxic Substance and Disease Registry (ATSDR) participated as well, at NRC's request.

DISCUSSION: ATSDR (Paul Charp) discussed the methods and findings of a July 2002 site exposure investigation. Dr. Charp concluded that by his independent methods, he found no imminent danger to the public from radiological material at the slag pile site.

PADEP presented a number of questions regarding the site. Specifically, they had questions about the site source term, characterization, dose assessment, land use and other issues. Each point was discussed by all in attendance.

NRC presented it's findings regarding site conditions and articulated concerns about some uncertainty of the site characterization and appropriate modeling conditions under an erosion scenario.

ACTIONS: NRC committed to providing a request for additional information to the licensee in the near future.
