

APPLICANT'S MOTION FOR PAGE LIMIT EXTENSION

In its Order of April 4, 2003, the Board authorized PFS to file a reply to other parties' filings on the issues specified in the Order. The Board did not specify any page limits for the reply. Because PFS is responding to the filings of both the State and the Staff, it finds that it will need 15 pages for its reply. 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
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
