Given the current state of affairs with information security, we raised this to Mindy Landau because some of the information in the CNS report is lifted from the Information Digest, which is being scrutinized. We decided this morning that we would not release the report until it cleared the screening group and have provided a copy to Bill Reckley. We've already decided to remove any details that give more than the city and State of plants. We're also having the PRA/accident precursor material reviewed. For the moment, we are in a hold mode knowing that we must revise ANNEX 1 at a minimum; we'll get back with you as soon as we know more. Thanks for keeping up with this.
