Hi, Chet. Sorry for taking so long to respond -- sick kids and an overabundance of information requests have been keeping me busy.

The meeting was informative and useful. I spoke with most of the state participants from the Midwest and have put together some draft comments that the states are now reviewing. I will definitely have something to send prior to the May deadline.

The only negative comments I have heard related to the prominence of the Nevada officials at the meeting. The consensus seems to be that the "regional" meetings should have had a regional "flavor." Nevada certainly had a right to be present at all the public workshops, but the states question the decision to invite Nevada to sit at the table at all four meetings. From the audience, I did notice that the number of non-Nevada comments diminished as the day wore on -- very likely because of the great number of statistics, reports, analyses, and other information that Bob Halstead had in his arsenal.

At any rate, I'm glad a good number of people turned out for the meeting. Thanks for seeking our input. And please let me know if I can be of assistance on future projects.
