As with the NRC, these companies were not releasing emergency planning information post 09/11. I confirmed those facts before calling you. In fact, at least one utility company pointed to the fact that NRC had pulled emergency planning information from the public domain as justification for their own actions.

Dave - your Congressional testimony of April 11 quoted me on the subject of emergency planning, leaving out one essential part. I recall our conversation and your question as to when we would put the nuclear plant emergency plans back on the web, or in ADAMS. The part of my reply which you omitted in your testimony was that emergency planning information for residents in the plant emergency planning zone is provided to the residents by the utility. Therefore, your quote was certainly inaccurate by being incomplete, and created the completely false impression that I was dismissing the public's need for information. If you had checked with me before putting this in your testimony, I could have provided you with the accurate information.
