In response to your questions, here is additional information:

* The R&D activities in Pennington will be consistent with current operations. With the consolidation of research staff from our Wilmington facility, we simply will be doing more routine work. No radio synthesis work will occur in Pennington.

* The typical quantities per experiment range from ~10 microcuries to ~1 millicurie.
