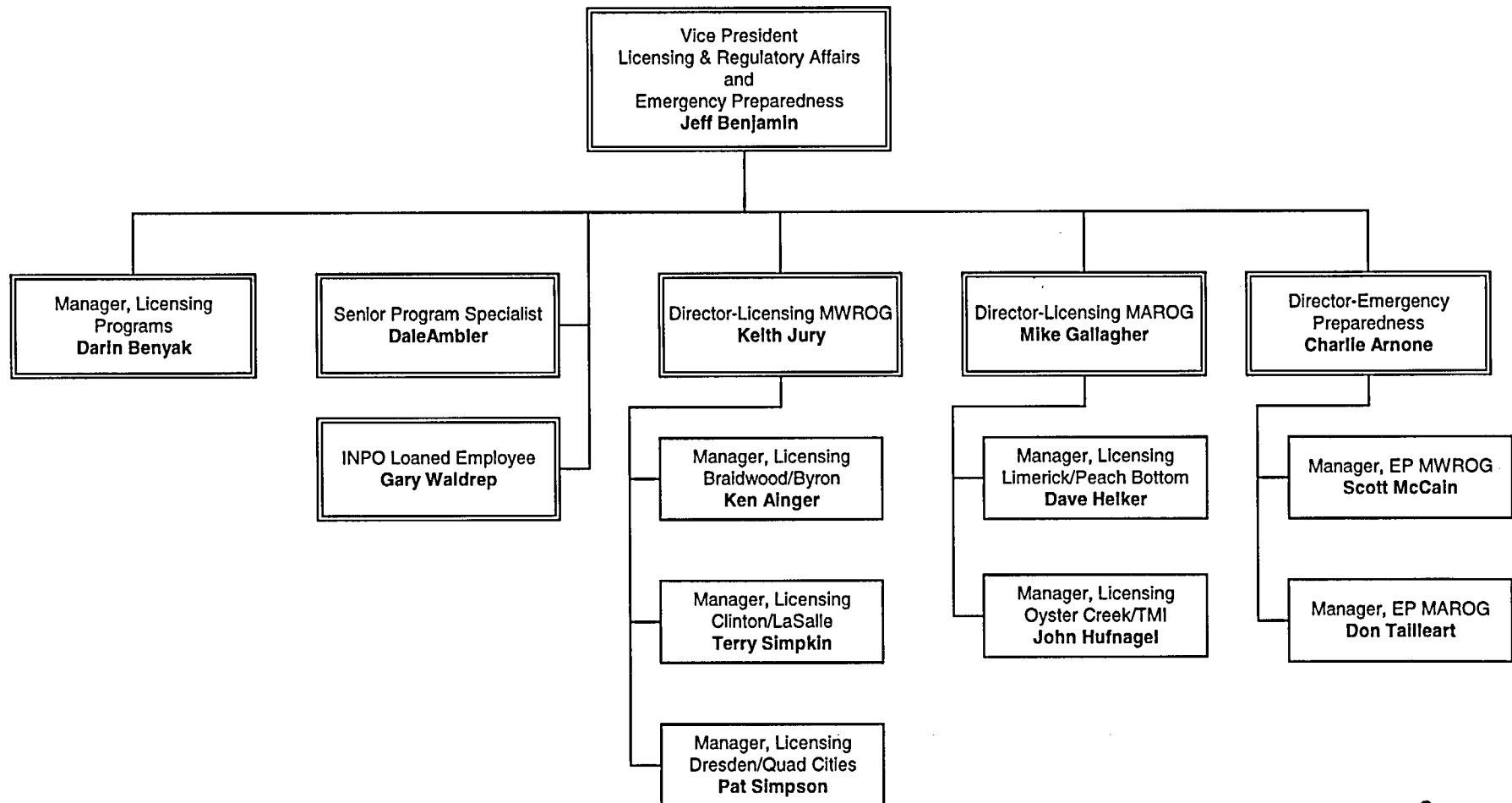

 - Take advantage of 20 year interval for later plants if available

 - Dresden currently targeted for November 2003 submittal
 - Others several years away (LGS, Byron, Braidwood, Peach Bottom 2, Oyster Creek)
