
On January 7, 2003, the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) issued an Order requiring compensatory measures (CMs) related to access authorization for all operating nuclear power reactor licensees (the Order). Virginia Electric and Power Company (Dominion) submitted an answer to the Order on January 27, 2003 (Serial No. 03-067). Dominion provided additional information in a letter dated March 25, 2003 (Serial No. 03-067A).

The purpose of this letter is to provide information related to CMs C.1.5 and C.1.9, which is included in the attachment. The information related to CM C.1.5 is provided in response to a telephone conversation on May 1, 2003 with Mr. Michael Burrell, Mr. M. C. Nolan and Mr. Christopher Gratton of the NRC. A schedule change is included for CM C.1.9 due to unforeseen delays in the industry's issuance of NEI 03-02, Standardized Industry Audit Process For Licensee Approved Contractor/Vendor Access.

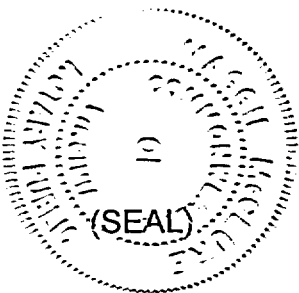
