Dear Secretary:

This is my comment on  
the NRC's proposed rulemaking on  
Control of Deposition of Solids (nuclear waste).

I am opposed to the release  
of even low-level waste from nuclear  
facilities. All materials that have been  
contaminated with radioactivity,  
no matter how slightly, must be  
disposed of only in a licensed nuclear  
dump, preferably at the same location  
as the nuclear facility. If necessary,  
expand the production sites' licenses  
to include storing & recontainerizing the  
wastes as their packaging deteriorates. The  
site should not later be released for un-  
restricted use. Thank you.
