EMCC is on my e-mail now wanting to know if there is a colorized, and presumably electronic version. They need to get a better visualization and representation of the stress contours.

The big issue at the moment is coming to "convergence" as I used the word yesterday, on exactly what kind of free surface area was presented by the exposed clad. So if you hear back from the licensee with a bottom line on the area of exposed clad, then I'd like to know that.

Do you know who might have the electronic version of that SSAR thing? (Tony, Doug - if you have a copy, you're welcome to pre-empt Steve and send it over).
